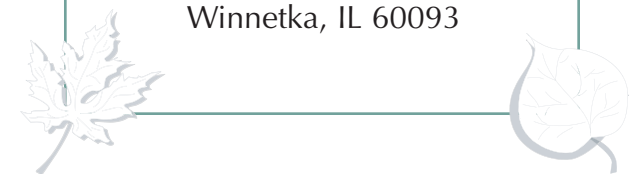

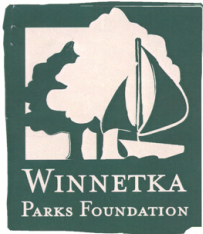

Dear Winnetka Resident:

The Winnetka Parks Foundation, (WPF) is a not-for-profit volunteer based organization created to provide resources beyond conventional public funding to enrich and enhance the Winnetka Park District. The WPF board members are fully committed to assisting the Winnetka Park District reach its full potential in terms of land acquisition, facility enhancement, parks beautification, and programming.



To that end, the WPF is honored to assist the Winnetka Park District with the Tree/Park Amenity Donation Program.

The Winnetka Park District is the steward of over 5,000 mature trees within the Winnetka parks, woodlands, and golf courses. Many trees are lost each year due to old age, disease, and weather-related damage. In an effort to maintain these parks to the highest standards, the Winnetka Parks Foundation, is asking Winnetka residents to participate in the Tree/Park Amenity Donation Program.

The Tree/Park Amenity Donation Program allows donors to honor an individual or group with the purchase of a tree or other park amenity, described below. All donations will be recognized on the Tree Donation Plaque in the Park District Administrative Offices. Donors of trees planted on the golf courses have the option of a plaque placed on the tree itself for an additional cost.

If desired, a Park District staff member will meet with you to discuss desired sites, tree or other park amenity options. The type of tree selected will be planted at the appropriate time of year to ensure optimal growth. SMALL TREES

Ornamental trees that remain under 25 feet tall, including flowering crabapples, redbud, service-berry, hawthorn, flowering dogwood, silverbell, river birch, and fringe trees.

Cost per tree: \$500

LARGE TREES

Large shade trees, including swamp white oak, bur oak, red oak, sugar maple, red maple, green ash, honey locust, American beech, green spruce, red pine, and white pine.

Cost per tree: \$750

ADDITIONAL PARK AMENITIES

The following park amenities are also available as donation possibilities:

BIRDHOUSES

Numerous nesting boxes for native nesting birds exist throughout our parks and golf courses. These boxes have helped considerably in reversing the decline of many songbirds. Cost: \$75

SHRUB PLANTINGS AND FLOWER BEDS

A variety of shrub plantings and flower beds may be donated.
